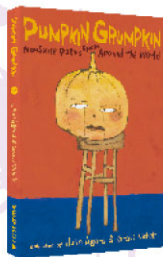

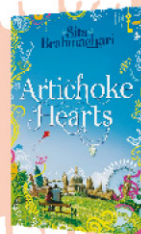


Pumpkin Grumpkin

A collection of silly poems from around the globe, brought to life with quirky illustrations. There's something for everyone in this fun and varied poetry selection. **Pages: 128**

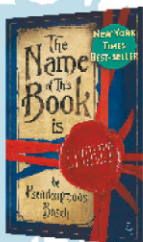
Artichoke Hearts

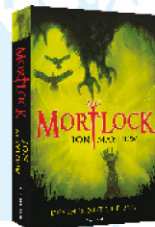


How to Train Your Dragon

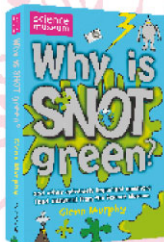

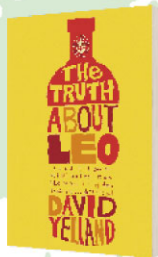
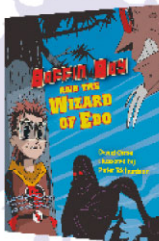
Dead Man's Cove

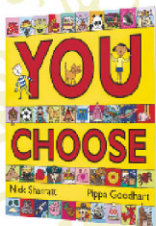


Little Bo Peep Has Knickers That Bleep
